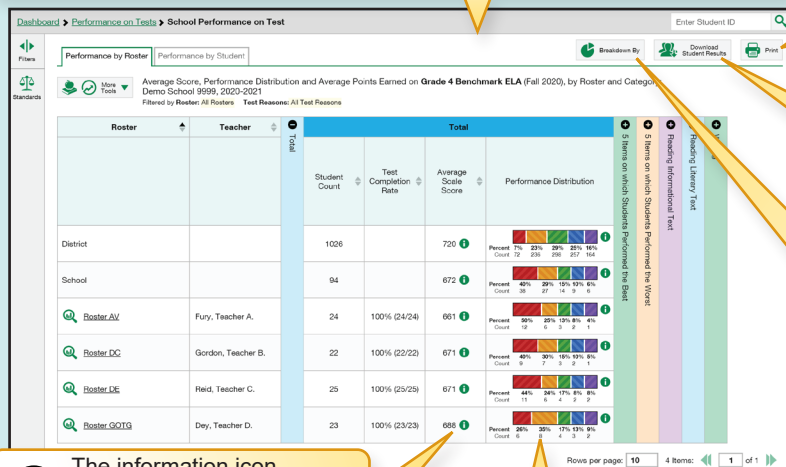
Why are we moving to the Centralized Reporting System?

The Centralized Reporting System (CRS) offers a more user-friendly interface that provides teachers and administrators with results for all Ohio assessments, in a single system.

- Results available for OST, AASCD, OELPA, OELPS, OGT, Benchmark and Checkpoint tests all in one reporting system
- View strengths and weaknesses at the student, class, school and district levels by identifying the five items with the highest and lowest scores for certain tests
- The ability to see actual student responses along with the item, for certain tests
- Guidance for teachers to pinpoint gaps in conceptual understanding and areas for further instruction

Key Features of the Centralized Reporting System

Each report is available for district, school, teacher, class, or any special roster of students that users want to follow.



Print reports in PDF and export data to Excel or CSV.



Individual student reports and student data files can be generated through an easy-to-use wizard.

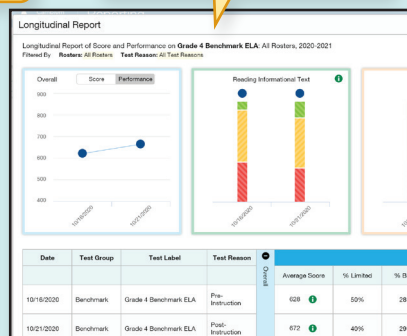
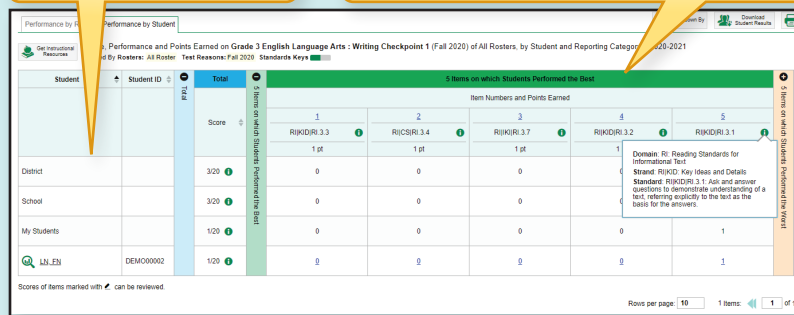
The information icon allows users to learn more on performance and scores.

Users can quickly view the 5 Best or 5 Worst items. Users can view the student response to an item. Items are identified by content standard.

What will I be able to do in the Centralized Reporting System?

The Centralized Reporting System allows users to:

- Explore the data underlying the aggregate
- Drill down into progressively smaller groups of students
- Disaggregate the results by content areas
- Track students back in time to examine trends
- Customize your reports
- Immediately generate your own data files
- Generate PDFs on demand for use in professional development activities

When will I be able to access my students' scores in the Centralized Reporting System?

Educators and administrators will be able to access reports and data in the Centralized Reporting System starting in August 2021.

Will I be able to access my prior year's data in the Centralized Reporting System?

Yes, all data housed in ORS for Ohio's State Tests (OST) in English Language Arts, Mathematics, Science and Social Studies, the AASCD, OELPA, OELPS, OGT, Restart Readiness Assessments (RRA) will be accessible in the Centralized Reporting System.

Will the online student report in the Centralized Reporting System look the same as before? Will I still be able to print student reports in the new system?

Yes, the online student report will look the same as previously reported in ORS. You will be able to access student reports in the Centralized Reporting System and can print these reports using the ISR Wizard.

- Teachers can print a single report for one student or generate a batch of multiple reports delivered as a ZIP file.
- The Student Results Generator also allows users to print or export a Student Data File, which is a teacher-friendly data spreadsheet of details from the Individual Student Reports (ISRs) and more.
